2. Consider Resolution Regarding the Sale of Alcohol Within 300 Feet of a Public School

The Board adopted the resolution requesting that the City of Kerrville enforce the Kerrville, Texas Code of Ordinances, Chapter 10 Section 10-6, that prohibits the location of a business engaged in the sale of alcohol from being located less than 300 feet, as measured by state statute, from Hill Country High School.
