The purposes of At-Risk Intervention Programs are to enhance the intellectual, emotional, social, and physical growth of students who could be potentially at-risk for dropping out of school. Program services allow for optional parent involvement, early identification and intervention, regularly scheduled assessment of student progress, and re-evaluation of program effectiveness. Program services range from mentoring, tutoring, summer school services, credit retrieval (high school) and a variety other services.
