



HPMS STUDENTS WIN MULTIPLE MEDALS IN NUMEROUS CATAGORIES UIL Tournament of Champions Results

Twenty-eight (28) 7th and 8th grade students from Hal Peterson Middle School (HPMS) earned entry to the University Interscholastic League (UIL) Tournament of Champions, netting 26 medals.
