1. TASB Loss Prevention Grant Report

Mr. Ed Thompson, TASB Director of Loss Prevention Services, Mr. Dell Harrington, Senior Loss Prevention Consultant, and Mr. Gary Armstrong, TASB Senior Risk Management Consultant, presented the district a monetary award of \$4,000 for use in the cafeterias. The funds will be utilized to purchase racks for the delivery and distribution of milk and for mobile security carts for chemicals and cleaning products.
