Scholarship for Military Children - (<http://www.commissaries.com>) Only dependent, unmarried children, younger than age 21 (age 23 if enrolled as a full-time student at a college or university) of active duty personnel, Reserve, Guard and retired military members, survivors of service members who died while on active duty, or survivors of individuals who died while receiving retired pay from the military may apply for a scholarship. Deadline to apply is Feb. 19th.

Financial Women in Texas - Hill Country Group will award a scholarship to a student graduating from a Hill Country area high school in Spring 2010; planning to attend a university, college, or vocational school in Fall 2010; has a GPA of 3.0 or better; and plans to major in business or finance. Deadline to apply is Feb. 28th. See Mrs. Storey for an application.

KPAS Performing Arts Scholarship - Three scholarships will be awarded to successful applicants who will further their education as a major in instrumental music, vocal music, or dance. You must submit your application by **March 19th** and auditions will be held on **Sat., March 27th**. See Mrs. Storey for an application.

Texas Trial Lawyers Association will award true need-based scholarships of \$1,000 each to high school seniors statewide.
