### **KISD's Park and Ride Football Shuttle Continues**



#### ***YOUR YELLOW LIMO AWAITS YOU!***

For the fifth consecutive season, Kerrville Independent School District (KISD) will offer a free shuttle service to and from Antler Stadium for all Tivy Antler home football games beginning Friday, September 2nd. The “Antler Tram” will run continuously starting at 6:30 p.m. through game conclusion. Shuttle pick up and return is at Hal Peterson Middle School (HPMS) off Sidney Baker and Tennis Street. The complimentary shuttle provides Tivy fans and visitors a convenient and complimentary way to get to and from the stadium, eases traffic and congestion in the area surrounding the stadium, safely delivers fans to the front gate of Antler Stadium then returns them to their vehicles at HPMS.

The shuttle will pick up riders at HPMS and drop them off at the front ticket gate facing Sidney Baker South. Shuttles will run as needed to return riders to their vehicles and security will be provided in the Peterson lot. Of note, KISD will offer a handicapped assessable bus for tram fans needing special assistance throughout the season.

An added feature for Tivy fans this year is a new area designated for recreational vehicles. RV's and buses can become Tivy Tailgaters and utilize the spacious level parking area behind HPMS. As implemented in 2009, RV's, buses, and large vehicles will no longer be allowed within the stadium area for safety and space restrictions.
