KISD Health Protocols for 2022-23 (Covid-19 Updated Procedures)

HYGIENE AND CLEANING

- Kerrville ISD will continue to encourage frequent handwashing and use of hand sanitizing stations.
- KISD will continue to regularly clean high traffic surfaces.
- KISD will continue to provide cleaning supplies for teachers for disinfection of classrooms.
- Students and staff wanting to wear a face mask are welcome to do so.

SYMPTOMATIC / CONFIRMED POSITIVE COVID-19

- Students and staff who are symptomatic (sick) should not come to school.
- If sick, remain home until fever free for 24 hours (without fever reducing medications), or if no fever, remain home until reduction of symptoms.
- If confirmed positive for Covid-19, it is recommended that students and staff report the positive test result to your school and quarantine for five days from symptom onset.

EXPOSURE / NOTIFICATIONS

- Contact tracing will not be conducted.
- Students and staff *will not* be required to quarantine or self-isolate for close contact to a person confirmed positive for Covid-19.
- Parent notifications will not be provided for Covid-19 positive students/staff on campus.

COVID-19 TESTING

• Covid-19 testing will be available for students (who have in-home close-contact and are asymptomatic) and for staff, by appointment, in the campus clinic, until the end of the Fall Semester of 2022.

STAFF LEAVE / STUDENT ABSENCES
