Friday, October 22nd - HOMECOMING GAME Pre-Game Rehearsal at 8:00 a.m., gym (For all sweethearts, escorts, dukes, and duchesses). Sashes distributed and pre-game line-up begins at 6:00 p.m. Ceremonies begin at 7:00 p.m.

HOMEcoming RULES AND REGULATIONS

PARADE INFORMATION

Each organization will be responsible for obtaining a car for their sweethearts. The occupants need to be visibly identified in the car. For example, a sign that reads “Sophomore Sweethearts” is sufficient.

Each organization will be designated a line-up number and must line-up accordingly along Hugo Street by 5:30, prior to the start of the parade. Friendly competition is fine but detrimental or dangerous behavior will result in immediate expulsion from the parade. In addition, appropriate attire is also required with understanding that the dress is according to your theme selection. No candy or items are allowed to be thrown from the floats per Kerrville Police Department. Floats that do may be removed from the lineup. However, those walking the parade may *hand* candy or other appropriate treats to children along the parade route.

FLOAT DECORATIONS

All parade entries need to correspond with Homecoming theme: **Road Trip – National Treasures**

Turn in the specific theme selected by the class or organization to Mrs. Portillo by September 20th. Theme selection is on a first-come first-serve basis and no two organizations will share the same theme. Theme choices must be appropriate.

Planning and float construction by students must be **under adult supervision at all times.**

No more than \$100 may be spent from class funds for decorating floats.

Turn in purchase orders to Mrs. Graham by noon on Friday if you want them back by the next Wed/Thursday.

Get creative with decorations! Salvage parents’ garages and so forth. Check out Pinterest for ideas!

DESIGNATED WORK TIMES:

Sponsors, share the work load and don’t overwork yourselves! Work may begin October 6th.

You as the club/organization sponsor must decide how and when your group wishes to work.

For example: you might schedule float building Mon-Thurs 5-9 and Sat 10-4. Adults can sign up for 1-2 hour shifts or whatever works best for you.

Sponsors, please keep in mind that this is an opportunity for students to learn the value of collaboration, leadership and yes, problem-based learning. They will need your help. Please assist students through this process by helping them plan and offering guidance. You might even end up having some fun!

Please follow all standard protocols in regard to student safety.

HALL DECORATIONS- This year, hall decorating is a way for students to show their Tivy Spirit. **Decorate your designated hallway with either BLUE and GOLD or with your chosen theme!**

Hall assignments are as follows:

Seniors (Clarkson and Nouri): G Wing (from the double doors to the stairs (do not pass West or Dunigan's room)

Sophomores (Tolbert): D Wing (from the double doors to the end of the main strip)

Juniors (Vecchio and Heath): A Wing (from the double doors to the end of the main strip)

Freshmen (Riley and Dunigan): F Wing (from the double doors to the end of the main strip)

- No more than \$50 from your class funds may be spent decorating the wing. Get creative!
- Signs cannot be painted in the hallway.
- No shoe-paint writing on the windows ANYWHERE.
- Remember that lockers must be available for students' use daily.
- Hall decorating will take place on Wednesday, October 20th from 3:30 – 6:00 p.m.
- At least one class sponsor must be present during decorating. Check to make sure an adult sponsor is THERE!!!!
- All hall decorations need to be removed and each area cleaned by 4:30 p.m. Friday, October 20th.
