



APPLICATION AND AGREEMENT FOR TIVY HIGH SCHOOL AIR FORCE JUNIOR RESERVE OFFICER TRAINING COURSE

I. FOREWARD

Air Force Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (AFJROTC) is a full credit elective course offered by Tivy High School. It is a unique course of instruction because AFJROTC has requirements that must be met before credit is awarded. This agreement communicates general guidelines concerning the requirements of students enrolled in AFJROTC here at Tivy High School. **Participation in AFJROTC DOES NOT commit or obligate a student to military service** nor does it guarantee special consideration if a student chooses to enter military service. However, a student who completes two or more years of AFJROTC **may** qualify for advanced rank upon enlistment and completion of Basic Military Training. AFJROTC remains foremost a Citizenship and Leadership Development program.

II. APPLICATION

I, (Cadet) _____, hereby apply for enrollment in Tivy High School AFJROTC.

III. AGREEMENT

A. Upon acceptance of this application by the student, the Tivy High School AFJROTC instructor staff agrees to:

1. Provide each student Aerospace Science and Leadership textbooks for classroom use.
2. Issue an AFJROTC uniform (including shoes) and Physical Training gear to each student.
3. Provide instruction based on the AFJROTC program objectives enabling students to:
 - a. Develop a high degree of strong morals, self-esteem, self-reliance, personal appearance, and leadership.
 - b. Adhere to the Air Force core values of integrity, service, and excellence.
 - c. Increase cadet understanding of patriotism and responsibilities as US citizens.
 - d. Participate in community service activities.
 - e. Expand cadet critical thinking and problem solving skills, communication, collaboration, and innovation.
 - f. Demonstrate military customs, courtesies, and traditions and develop habits of order, discipline, and social skills.
 - g. Acquire a broad-based knowledge of aerospace studies and leadership education.
 - h. Strive to graduate from high school and prepare for college and/or careers in the 21st century.
 - i. Cultivate a commitment to physical fitness and a healthy lifestyle.
4. Encourage academic achievement, career planning, and provide guidance regarding the continuing educational opportunities and scholarships available through the military academies and college Air Force ROTC.

B. In order to maintain the high standards of personal conduct, appearance, and courtesy required by Tivy High School AFJROTC, as a student, I understand and agree to:

1. Take proper care of textbooks, uniforms and equipment provided by AFJROTC and return them when required.
2. Wear the AFJROTC uniform only when prescribed by instructor staff. Refusal to wear the uniform or improper uniform use will result in my removal from this program and transfer to another class (NOTE: removal could occur at any time during the school year and result in no credit for the class or the class you are moved to.)
3. Maintain my uniform in a clean, properly fitted, and repaired condition (reference the Cadet Guide). Turn in the complete uniform upon withdrawal from Tivy High School or at the end of the school year. I am responsible for cleaning costs, loss, theft, or damage of uniform items.
4. Meet personal grooming and appearance standards established by this high school and AFJROTC.
5. Meet established behavior standards of THS and JROTC. Students suspended from school for their behavior risk losing their cadet rank and leadership position. Students expelled or assigned to alternative school are removed from AFJROTC and must turn in all uniform items, books, and monies owed prior to withdrawal.
6. Maintain an acceptable standard of academic achievement, be active in classroom work, and participate in AFJROTC Leadership Development Requirements (Co-Curricular activities).
7. Meet the objectives of AFJROTC by developing:

- a. An appreciation of the basic elements and requirements for national security.
 - b. Respect for and an understanding of the need for constituted authority in a democratic society.
 - c. Patriotism and an understanding of personal obligation to contribute to national security.
 - d. Habits of orderliness and precision.
 - e. A high degree of personal honor, self-reliance and leadership.
 - f. A broad-based knowledge of the aerospace age and fundamental aerospace doctrine.
 - g. Basic military skills.
 - h. Knowledge of an appreciation for the traditions of the Air Force.
 - i. An interest in completing high school and pursuing higher educational goals or skills.
 - j. An understanding of the Air Force and military as a possible career path.
8. Respond positively to other students appointed to leadership positions in Tivy High School AFJROTC and conduct myself properly when placed in a position of leadership.
9. Strive to develop self-discipline and responsibility.
10. Refrain from all Social Media activity that discredits myself, my family, Corps of Cadets and Tivy High School.

I give my permission for my child, (Cadet) _____ to enroll in Tivy High School AFJROTC and will encourage his/her participation. I understand there is no military service obligation for participation in AFJROTC. I understand the high standards expected of a student in this program to include supervised physical fitness training and I will help my child achieve these standards. I understand that continuation/reenrollment in AFJROTC is not automatic and is based upon the cadet's previous academic/leadership performance and approval of the Senior Aerospace Science Instructor. I allow Tivy High School to take photographs of my child engaged in AFJROTC activities for use in student publications, photo boards, exhibits, etc., and on the Tivy High School and AFJROTC website. I also authorize Colonel Woods or Chief Master Sergeant Galifaro during the course of authorized school trips/functions to execute any or all documents necessary for my son/daughter to be treated by medical personnel during a medical emergency.

I understand my child can be removed from AFJROTC if he/she is unable or refuses to wear the uniform provided by AFJROTC, cannot meet established grooming standards, or is expelled or assigned to an alternative school (NOTE: removal can occur at any time during the school year and consequently the student could lose credit for the semester). Should my child be removed from the AFJROTC program we are required to first dry-clean and then turn in the issued uniform.
