## I Have Two Numbers

You need: a partner, paper/pencil
. Player 1 thinks of a subtraction problem with a difference less than 10. (Such as 13-7)
. Player 1 says: "I have two numbers. Their difference is six. What are they?"
. Player 2 reports and records his/her guesses each time until the subtraction problem is found.

- Switch roles and play 3 more times.
. Count the number of guesses it took each time.
. The WINNER used the fewest clues.
